If you are feeling unwell or have any cough or fever symptoms, please refer to Govt advice to self isolate for 7 days.

If you have been in self isolation due to first hand carrier contact, travel, or cold or fever symptoms, **DO NOT** attend any meeting or event unless you have been tested for CV19 and confirmed clear **OR** you have been 7 days symptom free after the end of isolation

At a Meeting

As Global Skill Resources does not have a fixed physical locations for training that we are responsible for, we will defer to any local policy or procedures enforced by the venues that we book. We mainly use large established hotel venues, and they have a vested interest to ensure that they provide a location that is as safe and clean as possible.

We will follow the simple advice to minimise the risks of CV19 transmission which will include (but not limited to):

- Regular handwashing
- Avoidance of physical contact, including handshaking. A polite wave and smile is encouraged instead of a handshake or “Fist bump”.
- Removal of staff or delegates that show symptoms of cold or flu
- Where possible we will provide increased spacing between seats

After a Meeting

If you subsequently are diagnosed as having CV19 and your Health Care Professional advises that you may have been contagious at the time of your meeting, you have the responsibility to contact us as soon as possible by emailing info@onlinebettingschool.com.

Please title your email: ‘MEGA - CV19 DIAGNOSIS’

We will then in confidence, and on the advice of Government or an HCP, contact other attendees to inform them. Your identity will be kept strictly confidential.
