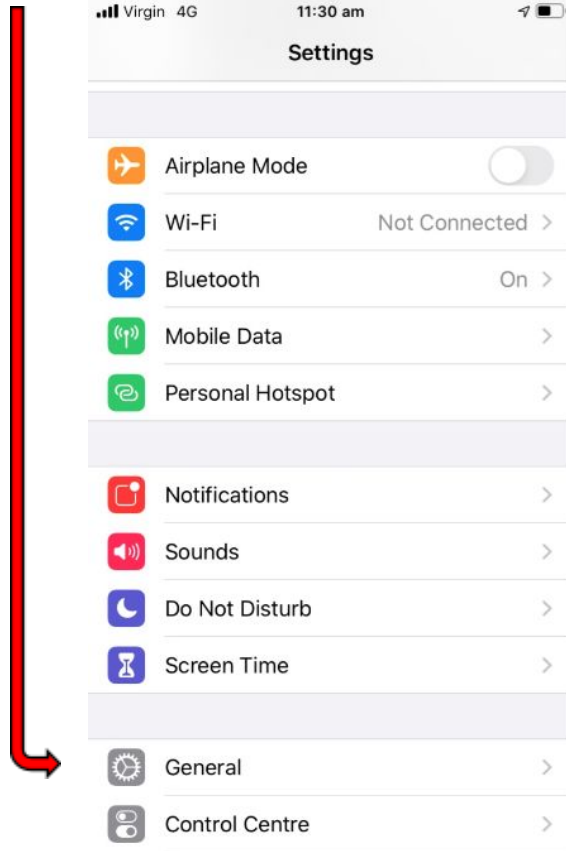


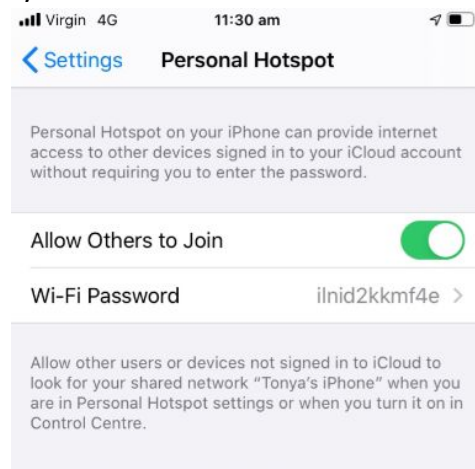
How to Tether from Your SmartPhone


Tethering from an Apple Phone

1. On your iPhone open up **[Settings]**
2. Look up your phone name. This will be your network name when you tether.
 - a. Within **[Settings]** select **[General]** > **[About]**.
 - b. If you wish to change this name, select **[Name]** and type a name you would like to use




3. To turn on tethering.
 - a. Return back to **[Settings]** and select **[Personal Hotspot]**, select **[Allow Others to Join]**. You will find your Wi-Fi Password underneath.



4. From your laptop select your Wi-Fi link . Find and select your iPhone name. You will be prompted to enter in the WiFi password.

Tethering from an Android Phone

1. Open up [**Settings**]
2. Select [**Connections**]
3. Select [**Mobile Hotspot and Tethering**]
4. Turn on [**Mobile Hotspot**]
5. Tap on [**Mobile Hotspot**]. This will show you your Android phone name (used as you network name) and your WiFi password
6. From your laptop select your Wi-Fi link . Find and select your Android phone name. You will be prompted to enter in the WiFi password.

If you would like to change your Android phone name from the default name

1. Open [**Settings**] on phone
2. Scroll down and Select [**About Phone**]
3. Select [**Edit**] under your phone name and then type the name you want
